



## Guidelines -COVID-19

Welcome to Malta and to ETI.

We kindly ask you to take a few minutes to read through this notification and kindly ask for your cooperation in keeping Malta one of the safest countries in controlling the spread the COVID 19. The safety and well-being of our guests, trainees and staff is a top priority for ETI and the Claret Group. We ask for your full cooperation in abiding by the following conditions during your training programme at ETI.



- Patrons will be subject to temperature checks at the entrance of the ESE Building and ETI entrance to check for the presence of fever. Persons with a temperature of 37.2°C or higher will be denied entrance.
- ETI will exercise the right of refusal of entry onto the premises of patrons if they are visibly unwell or have respiratory symptoms
- The ESE / ETI Building will provide with 70% alcohol hand-rub sanitizers at the entrance of the premises and on each floor throughout the building. We encourage you to ensure that you sanitise your hands throughout your stay.
- We invite to frequently wash your hands with soap and water throughout the day.
- The school will provide ongoing cleaning and sanitising of all the common areas and classrooms inside the premises using Ozone disinfection and sanitisation. This cleansing method is 100% environmentally safe and is an extremely effective method to disinfect against bacteria and viruses. Ozone kills bacteria about 3,200 times faster than chlorine making a more effective of sanitising.
- All trainees are required to wear a face mask or visor throughout the ETI and ESE Building and on terraces at all times throughout the stay and this includes during training sessions.
- You will be provided to reconfirm your personal details / place of accommodation and telephone numbers on registration at ETI. Cleaning and sanitization regimes will be documented.
- We encourage all to provide your own water/ drinks and not share these with other members.



- If you do feel unwell , you are asked to stay at your place of accommodation until symptoms. You are to call the ETI emergency number at **+356 21373789** or if need of a doctor please call **+356 9949 4115**. have completely resolved even if the result of the swab test does not detect COVID-19.



- Staff and trainees who have symptoms suggestive of COVID-19 are strongly advised to call 111 and arrange for testing for COVID 19.

- If you do feel unwell or developing other symptoms once you are at ETI or the school building, you are to speak to the ETI staff at reception. You will be invited to stay in an isolation room until we take necessary steps to address your symptoms.
